## WORKPLACE INCIDENT AT WELSHPOOL OPERATIONS, WESTERN AUSTRALIA

RCR Tomlinson Ltd (ASX code: RCR) advises that a worker has been fatally injured at its Welshpool Mining Facility in Western Australia this morning.

The incident occurred at approximately 7.30am WST during a routine fabrication procedure at the facility.

RCR and the worker's employer, Skilled, are currently notifying the worker's family of this tragic accident.

Counselling is being made available to both the family and RCR employees.

To respect the family's privacy, RCR has not released the name of the worker.

RCR's Chief Executive Officer, Paul Dalglish said the accident was deeply distressing for everyone, particularly for the family of the employee and his colleagues.

"Our immediate priority is to support both the family and our employees," Mr Dalglish said.

The company has suspended operations at the site of the incident while the Company and regulatory authorities, including WorkSafe, conduct their investigations into the incident.
